Every year, thousands of people in New York struggle with addiction, mental illness, and homelessness. These challenges can be overwhelming, and it can be difficult to see a way out. But there is hope.

Odyssey House is a behavioral healthcare nonprofit dedicated to helping people struggling with addiction, mental illness, and homelessness get back on their feet. We offer a wide range of programs, including residential and outpatient substance use treatment, supportive housing, primary medical care, employment training, and mental health services.

We help people begin recovery, find housing, and get jobs.

In 2022, we served over 2,600 people through our treatment and housing programs. Of these, 85% of residential clients and 71% of outpatient clients completed treatment and returned to their communities with all goals met.

We are proud of our accomplishments in 2022 and are committed to continuing our work. We believe that recovery is possible for everyone, and we are dedicated to providing the support and resources that people need to succeed.

Without the support of the following federal, state, and city agencies: the federal Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA); NYS Office of Addiction Services and Supports (OASAS), NYS Office of Mental Health (OMH), and NYS Department of Corrections and Community Supervision (DOCCS); NYC Human Resources Administration (HRA), NYC HIV/AIDS Services Administration (HASA), and NYC Department of Housing Preservation and Development, we would not be able to provide the comprehensive programs New Yorkers urgently need.

We are grateful for their investment in our services and for the ongoing support of all our other funders, donors, volunteers, and staff. Their generosity and dedication make it possible for us to help so many people.

Together, we can create a world where everyone has the opportunity to recover from addiction, mental illness, and homelessness and lead a healthy and rewarding life.

My favorite maxim is "personal growth before vested status."

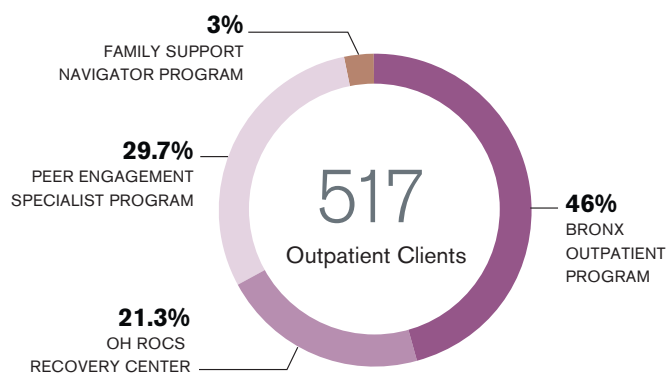
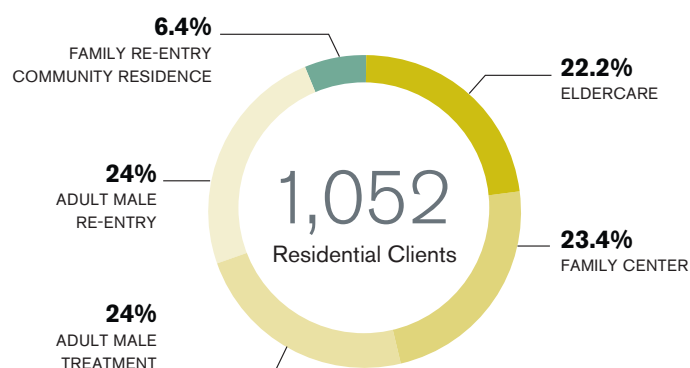

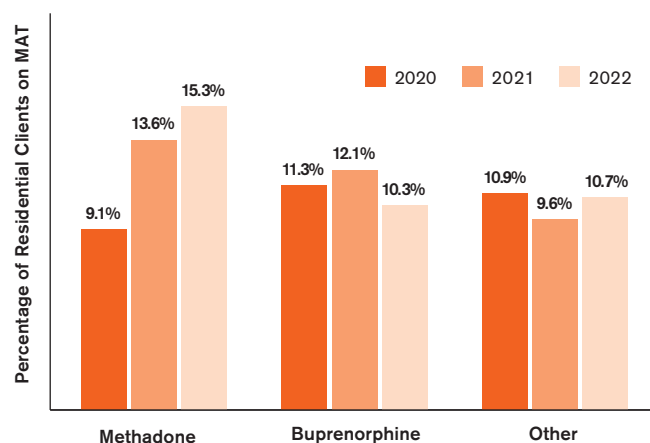

Enhancing Treatment: Integrating MAT for a Holistic Recovery



Odyssey House recognizes the value of integrating medication-assisted treatment (MAT) as an essential component of comprehensive treatment plans for individuals with substance use disorders. Our approach involves carefully assessing each client's needs and a collaborative, multidisciplinary team effort.

During the admission assessment process, we engage in open discussions with clients about the potential benefits and appropriateness of incorporating MAT into their treatment plans. We understand that treatment needs may evolve, so we continuously evaluate and adjust the approach to ensure the best outcomes for our clients.

I came to Odyssey House in 2022 because I knew I needed help. Being here has helped me a lot – I’m in a much better place than I was a year ago.

I came to Odyssey House to get my life back together – to get structure back into my life and to maintain a happy, healthy life in recovery.

I like “every day is a new day” because it’s true. Every day you get to push yourself. If you had a down day the day before, it’s in the past. The new day is the future – it’s you pushing forward to do better, to work better, to want better.

A day in treatment is a little day compared to the ones I’ll have in my future. It’s a stepping stone. Every day I push myself to do better and every day, I find a lesson. Whether I did something wrong or if I did something right, I learn from it.

Our implementation of MAT involves close collaboration among medical professionals, addiction specialists, and counselors. This team works together to develop a comprehensive treatment plan that includes on-site medication evaluation, prescription, administration, and ongoing monitoring.

By integrating MAT with a full range of evidence-based interventions and support services, such as counseling, behavioral therapies, education, and more, we address addiction’s complex psychological, emotional, and social drivers.

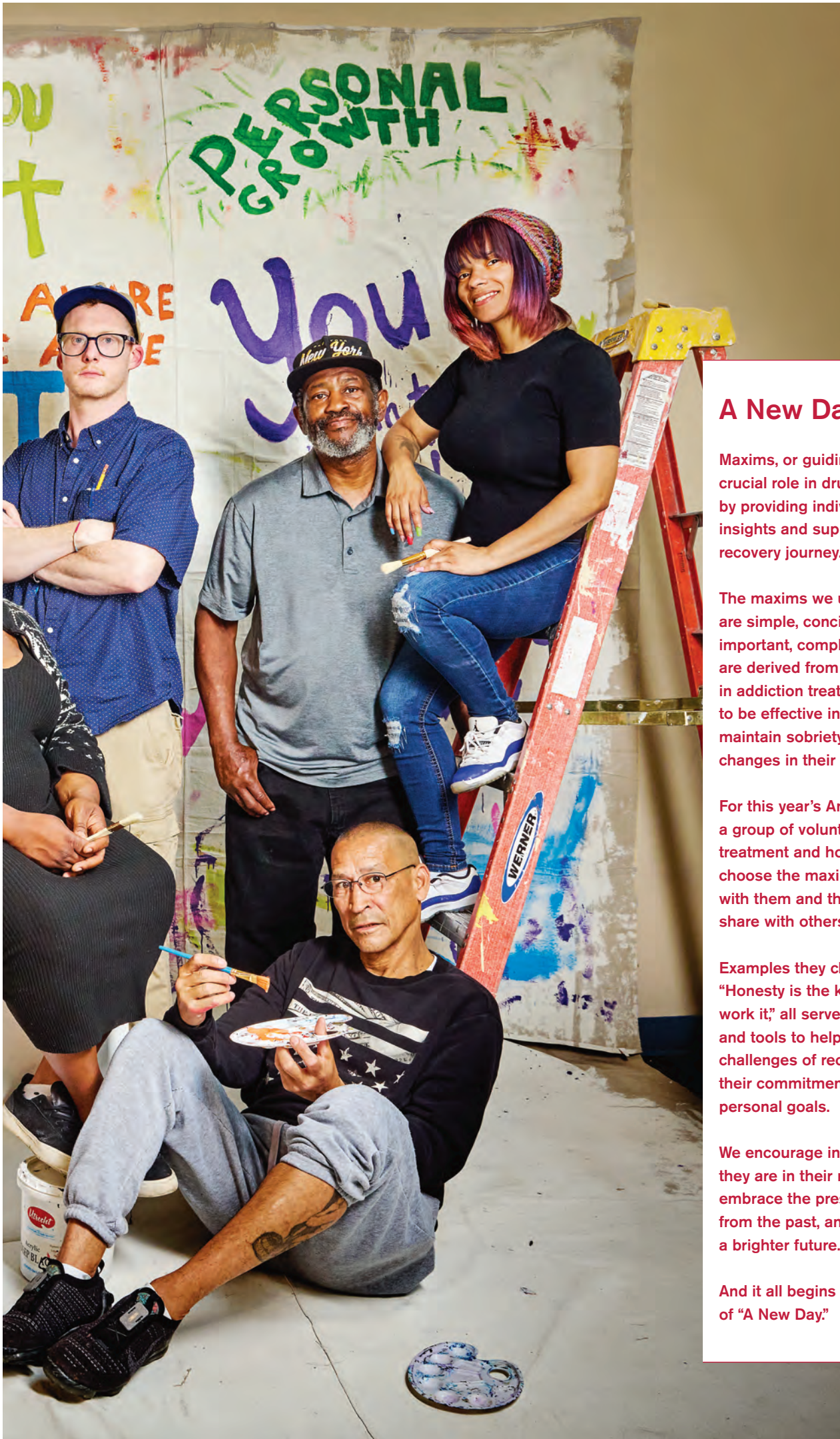
This holistic approach allows us to tackle underlying issues and equip individuals with the skills to manage

their recovery journey during the critical transition from residential treatment to community-based outpatient or recovery center models.

We have witnessed the positive impact of integrating MAT into our treatment approach, as demonstrated by the chart on page 6. It shows a notable increase in the utilization of MAT, particularly methadone, among our residential treatment participants from 2020 to 2022.

By embracing progress and integrating MAT into our treatment programs, we aim to provide comprehensive care that supports individuals in achieving long-term recovery and improved overall well-being.





A New Day

Maxims, or guiding principles, play a crucial role in drug treatment programs by providing individuals with valuable insights and support to aid their recovery journey.

The maxims we use at Odyssey House are simple, concise phrases that hold important, complex meanings. They are derived from years of experience in addiction treatment and have proven to be effective in helping individuals maintain sobriety and make positive changes in their lives.

For this year's Annual Report, we asked a group of volunteer participants in our treatment and housing programs to choose the maxim that resonated most with them and then paint it on a mural to share with others.

Examples they chose from: "Act as if," "Honesty is the key," and "It works if you work it," all serve as powerful reminders and tools to help them navigate the challenges of recovery and maintain their commitment to reaching their personal goals.

We encourage individuals, wherever they are in their recovery journey, to embrace the present moment, learn from the past, and actively work towards a brighter future.

And it all begins with the promise of "A New Day."

Recovery in the community

At Odyssey House, recovery encompasses more than simply achieving sobriety. It entails taking full responsibility for one's health, engaging in creative endeavors, preparing for a fulfilling career, and actively participating in the community. With this goal in mind, we organize numerous events and activities that promote long-term recovery through recreational pursuits, wellness education, opportunities for civic restoration, and social engagements.

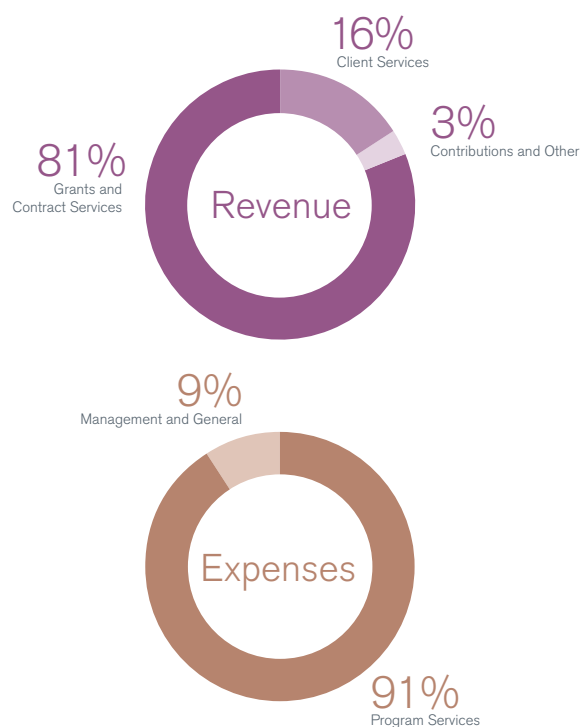
